OUR STORY

Established on June 1, 1922, the Rotary Club of Kitchener was the first Rotary Club in Kitchener- Waterloo and has been instrumental in forming the Waterloo Club, the Kitchener Conestoga Club, the Kitchener Westmount Club, and the Kitchener Grand River Club. The efforts of the members of the Kitchener Club led to the establishment of the Rotary Children's Centre – now KidsAbility Centre – the Kitchener-Waterloo Art Gallery, and the Rotary Peace Park located in RIM Park.

We were the first club in KW to support the inclusion of women in Rotary and founded the Rotary African Women's Education Fund. We have supported multiple local charities and institutions over the years and have developed or supported several international humanitarian projects.

Our club has been the recipient of many Rotary International Presidential Citations and we have had four club members serve as District Governor.
