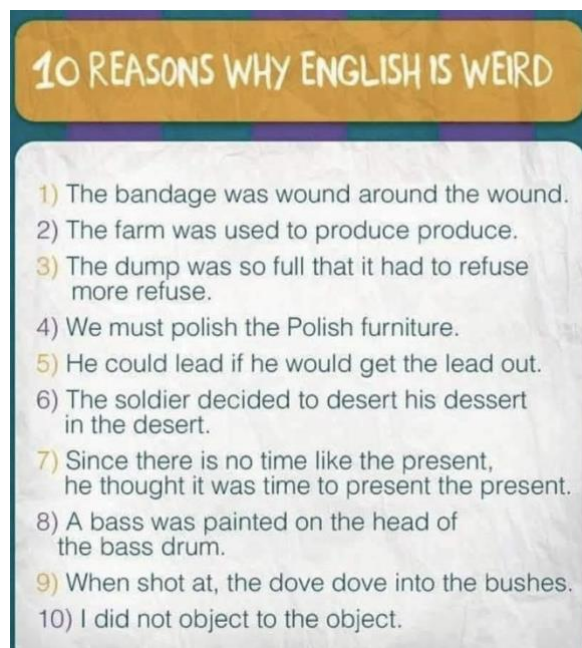
### Term 1, 'Quiet Achiever Award'

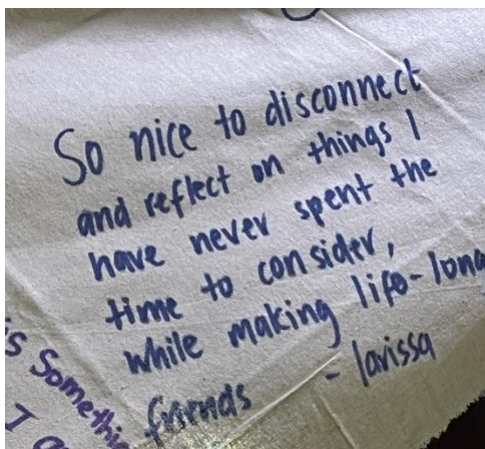
