Geelong Central Rotary Club, DG Philips club, supplied funds and labour for a twofold project. To build a class room in 2006 and follow up, with a dormitory to house teachers and students in 2007, in Garrthalala, a remote indigenous community, three hours' drive from Nhulumbuy in Arnhem Land. This project was also supported by the RC of Nhulumbuy. Judy went along with DG Philip, and was in charge of feeding the workers. She says, it was a fabulous experience. While there she met Janette Anderson a member of Bayside. A super club was good timing for Judy because of work commitments, and, as they say, the rest is history.

Judy also explained about District 9780, 2007 Friendship Exchange, a 12day trip to Thailand that she went on with Phillip. Comprising of six Rotarians and three partners from 5 different clubs. Judy remembers being treated like Royalty. Earlier that year, Judy said they were lucky to be able to host Rotarians from Thailand when they visited Geelong for 3 days.

Hence the name, Friendship Exchange. Thank you so much Judy for joining us for coffee. It was so interesting hearing about your Rotary experiences.
