Below is a step by step instruction on how to do this for Outlook:

- 1. On the Tools menu, click Options.
- 2. On the Preferences tab, under E-mail, click Junk E-mail.
- 3. Click the Safe Senders tab.
- 4. Select the Automatically add people I e-mail to the Safe Senders List check box.
- 5. Also add mailservice@clubrunner.ca and @clubrunner.email to your Safe Senders List

The process for other email platforms will be similar. Please update your Safe Senders

The Great Registration Race is a new way we will be promoting DonateLife Week for this year and runs all July and August, with a big push during DonateLife Week.
