### OPERATION POLLINATION

With the Village of Hawthorn Woods and other partners, we've planted and help maintain pollination friendly flora in parks, traffic islands, and private spaces. One of Rotary's Areas of Focus is supporting the environment.

### BLUE STAR ELECTRONIC RECYCLERS

Seen the Blue Star Rotary collection van in your neighborhood? We create local jobs for people with disabilities and remove electronic waste.

### LATIN AMERICAN DENTAL MISSION

Since 2000, Club members have traveled to nine countries for 17 dental missions. The program has delivered services worth \$1.5 million to more than 5000 patients.



Through **PolioPlus**, Rotary's most ambitious program to date, Rotary has played a leadership role with the World Health Organization, the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, and UNICEF in bringing the world to the brink of polio eradication. Rotary's **ENDPOLIONOW** campaign promotes public awareness and fundraising for the program. The Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation annually provides a two-for-one match for the first \$50 million of donations Rotary clubs and members make to support **PolioPlus**. Since 1985, Rotary has raised \$2.7 billion for the cause.
