FICO credit scores began in the 1950s to assist lenders with credit risks. There are over 50 different FICO formulas for various types of loans.

General factors used to determine credit scores:

35% payment history 30% balance 15% length of credit history 10% type of debt/credit (auto, mortgage) 10% number of inquiries Income is not used in determining FICO scores.

FAKO scores are those offered for free by banks and others. They will sell your info to advertisers. Do not accept their offers!

Best advise:

- . Pay off credit cards in full every month
- . Only close a credit card if it has an annual fee. If not, stop using it and let it expire
- . To "opt out" of offers go to prescreen.com
- . Get a free annual FICO score from annualcreditreport.com
- . FICO scores 720 or over are really good.
- . If you have a credit dispute, write a letter and send it certified mail. Repeat as needed when they ignore you. Do not report issue on line.
