PROGRAM ~ Vitaliy Bezrodnov ~ International Culture Exchange

Vitaliy was Born in the South of Soviet Union, now South Kazakhstan. He went to Music College and Conservatory in Russia. In 1994 he immigrated to the United States. Vitaliy was introduced to Rotary on the Russian-American district Conference in the 90s in Denver, Colorado. Later, he became member of the Lakewood-Rocky River Rotary Club (Cleveland area), Ohio. Since 2007, he is a member of Rotary Club of Fuquay-Varina, North Carolina,

Vitaliy is the Founder and Coordinator of the Rotary Children's

Fund. www.RotaryChildrensFund.org. Its mission includes:

 Allowing young artists & musicians worldwide to share their gifts and talents. To introduce the culture of their country to the American people and learn about the United States of America.
Improving good will between the people of America and other countries. Developing a better understanding of cultures, music and traditions. Building Cultural Bridges.
Providing financial support to orphans and other children in need.

Since 2003, Vitaliy is also the Coordinator for **Cultural Youth Exchange Program Golden Gates** (Russia, Georgia, Kazakhstan, Lithuania, Armenia, Serbia, Croatia, etc.). Each Group comes to tour the US for 2-4 weeks with the cultural Program and performs for 15-50,000 people (students/seniors/others) per tour.

The goal of the Culture Youth Exchange program is to make the world a better place by fostering understanding about different cultures. The program hopes to resume its travels in August.
