Rotary is an organization of more than 1.3 million business and professional leaders who are united worldwide; providing humanitarian services, encouraging high ethical standards in all vocations, and helping to build goodwill and peace in the world.

It is the oldest (established in 1905) and the largest service organization in the world, with more than 1.3 million Rotarians in more than 31,000 Rotary Clubs in 166 countries.

While each of Rotary's 31,000 clubs is a part of Rotary International, each club is autonomous: having its own by-laws, and free to create specific solutions to meet local community needs.
