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

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Pedal for Polio Day Fundraiser

- In Honour of Dr. Ron Mergl, DVM, Rotary Club of Niagara Falls, Canada
- Saturday October 24, 2020
- Goal of \$200,000 (\$50 x 2,000 Rotarians and an additional \$50 from a friend, family member or colleague)
- A 66 Rotary Club bike ride to NOTL COMMUNITY CENTER from Queenston/Lewiston





Support of The Rotary Foundation

- 1. Increase the Profile of the District Foundation Team and Programs (Zoom presentations)
- 2. Approach Clubs who have traditionally not supported TRF and encourage modest financial support
- 3. Identify Foundation Ambassadors in each club and provide them with the resources required
- 4. Challenge every member to add TRF as their charity of choice in addition to any other charities
- 5. Continue to support the Global Polio Eradication Initiative (GPEI) (Pedal for Polio)
- 6. Encourage smaller clubs to meet EREY / Sustaining clubs status by apportioning some of their revenue to TRF or to give a portion of their clubs dues to TRF





- Create 3-4 new Clubs such as Passport or Satellite Clubs in municipalities where there are no Rotary Clubs, ie. Smithville, Port Colborne, Thorold, Paris and Port Dover
- I.D. potential municipalities in New York State
- Increase Club membership by 250 by June 30, 2021
- Increase Rotaract and Interact Clubs by 3-4

In order to qualify for The Lighthouse Award clubs **must** complete the qualifications for RI President HOLGER KNAAK'S **Rotary Citation Award**. (Achieve 13 of the 25 RI Goals) In addition, clubs must also achieve the following before the end of the current Rotary Year 30 June, 2021. The date, time and location of award presentations will be determined after 30 Junn, 2021.

- 1. At least two members participate in the Grant Management Seminar and successfully complete the grant qualification process
- 2. At least one member participate in Rotary Leadership Institute
- 3. President Elect participates in each segment of PETS
- 4. Club member(s) attend the District Conference

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5. President, President Elect or their designee attend at least two Area Meetings 6. Club participates in Earth Day Waterside Clean-up 7. Club participates in Pedal for Polio fundraiser 8. Club achieves TRF's EREY or Sustaining Member designation 9. Club has a Strategic Plan and reviews it annually 10. Club supports at least one Youth Program ie. Scholarship, RYLA, SLAPSHOT, Rotaract, Earlyact or Interact Club
