Objectives

Responsibilities:

- Transport cases of beer, cider and wine from the outdoor cooler into the bar area within the Summerfest area
- Restock coolers and move empty cases, empty bottles, and empty cans from behind the bar as needed

- SMART Serve Certification
- Must be 18+
- Able to lift 30lb+

Role 4: Server

Objectives

- To serve beer, cider, or wine at Summerfest

Responsibilities:

- Serve beer, cider, or wine to customers
- Accept alcohol tickets in the appropriate bin
- Pour the appropriate/standardized serving of alcohol per ticket
- Recognize when to cut someone off
- Practice SMART Serve principles

Time Commitment:

- Valid SMART Serve Certificate required for serving
- Must be 18+ to serve alcohol

Objectives

- Ensure flow of the concert series

Role 7: Summerfest Ambassador

Objectives

- Ask short survey questions to incoming guests as part of a Summerfest demographic survey
- Offer info packages

Role 8: Golf Attendant

Objectives

- Take back equipment when participants are finished their round
