

## Fees & Contribution as a Rotarian

- Induction fee of \$100, one time
- Dues - \$62/Q Active Members
- Dues - \$52/Q Active Exempt
- Dues - \$75/Q Evening Group\*
- Meals – approx. \$300/Q
- Back-to-School Supplies - \$40/Q (our main local project, optional)
- Other Club Projects are voluntary but some level of participation is expected.

\*Evening Group, meets 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesday evening at 5:30, the initiation fee is \$50, and members pay for what they eat the meetings. There are \$75/Q dues. You may attend the main club luncheons and pay for meals at \$25 each.
