Paving the way for an end-of-life path



We're all headed there: the exit ramp. How we steer those end-of-life choices often can be up to us. For more than 30 years, Compassion & Choices (its affiliates and predecessors) has led most of the significant advances in the movement to expand and improve end-of-life options and care.

Areas of advocacy include advance care planning, end-of-life support, palliative care and pain management, and medical aid-in-dying (now authorized in 10 states).
