## First-term incumbents want seats again; independent challenger vies for valley

The next legislature faces a massive structural deficit, a resistance to new revenue and a public that expects a significant annual dividend. Three Juneau candidates want to do that work. Two are first-term

Democratic incumbents who have been part of a bi-partisan majority in the House. One of them, Sara Hannan, has no opposition. She is a life-long Alaskan and 30-year Juneau educator. She represents District 33, which includes downtown, Douglas, Lemon Creek, Haines, Klukwan, Gustavus, Skagway and Excursion Inlet.

Andi Story, represents District 34, which includes the valley and out the road. She is 34-year Juneau resident, former social worker, five-term School Board member, and a founder of Great Alaskan Schools, which helps parents become citizen lobbyists on behalf of education.

Her challenger Ed King is a combat veteran who came to Alaska with the Army. He is running as a non-partisan. King was an economist under the three most recent governors, including chief economist in the Dunleavy administration. King is owns a small economics consulting firm.
