Changing Arctic invites attention



While Juneau awaits the return of cruise ships to Southeast waters, the world

awaits a ship route across Arctic waters. Change in the Arctic is happening quickly, driven by climate change and international interest in the region as it becomes more accessible.

Former Juneau mayor Fran Ulmer is chair of the U.S. Arctic Research Commission and Special Advisor to the State Department on the Arctic. She is a senior fellow at Harvard's Belfer Center which focuses on the intersection of international security and science. Ulmer is a former state legislator from Juneau, former lieutenant governor of Alaska and former chancellor of UA Anchorage. Trained as a lawyer at the University of Wisconsin, she has served as a visiting professor at Stanford and Harvard and has lectured on the Arctic from Antarctica to the North Pole.
