Juneau-Gastineau Rotary Club's 2nd Annual ARC - Assemblages Recycle Competition April 17, 2021 Juneau Arts & Cultural Center

OVERVIEW

The 2nd Annual ARC is a Juneau-Gastineau Rotary (JGR) Club fundraising event with all proceeds benefiting our Club's youth activities and programs; our youth activities and programs are at the heart of our Club.

Here are just a few of our activities centered on youth:

Auke Bay Elementary Playground Equipment, Riverbend School Playground Equipment, Family Day at the Lake, Zach Gordon Youth Center Upgrades, After School Coalition Sponsorship, Sponsoring Youth Exchange Students, Sponsoring local students for Rotary Youth Leadership Awards, Lena Point Park Dugouts, West Juneau & Bonnie Brae Children's Parks, and Youth Scholarships and Recognition.

Our Assemblages Recycle Competition (**ARC**) has two (2) parts:

- **The first part** is a 4-person team contest that is a timed live event. Teams will build Assemblage piece(s), often but not always as a "robot" type of sculpture all from provided materials within the allotted time. Each team will receive a main ingredient just prior to the start which must be used in their assemblage.
- **The second part** is a Call for Artists to create a piece, prior to the event, to be entered into the ARC Juried Show.

Juried pieces may be sold with proceeds going to the Artist and JGR (with a 70/30 split). The pieces submitted for the Juried Show will be on display around town starting on First Friday, April 2, until the ARC - Assemblages Recycled Competition event on April 17. The pieces will then be moved to the JACC for judging. (See website for details.)

The rules that the judges will use for both the Call for Artists and Team pieces are as follows:

- 30%: Constructive use of all building materials
- 30%: Execution
- 30%: Recognizable creation
- 10%: Over the top look and execution

Prizes for the competitions are as follows:

- **ARC Team Competition:**
 - **Best in Show** - Judged -- 4 Confirmed Tickets on Temsco's Glacier Dog Sled Tour!
 - **Crowd Favorite** – Gastineau Guiding Whale Watching Trip for 4!
- **Juried Show:**
 - **Grand Prize** -- 2 Roundtrip Tickets on Alaska Seaplanes, confirmed space-including Whitehorse, Yukon!

Plus, we will have door prizes as well where ticket holders must be present to win:

- **Midway Door Prize:** Wings Airways, 5-Glacier Flight-seeing trip for 2
- **Main Door Prize:** Wings Airways, Taku Lodge trip for 2

We will once again have Tom Sullivan as our Emcee and Tim Banaszak as our Roving Reporter throughout the event (think TV's Iron Chef!).

Entrance to the event to watch the competition is \$5.00 per person; children 10 and younger are free. Paid ticket holders (10+ and older) will receive 5 chips plus 1 Door Prize Ticket – additional door prize tickets and chips may be purchased throughout the event. Additional door prize tickets are \$5 per ticket and additional chips are \$1 per chip. Note: you must be present to win either door prize!

Chips will be used to vote for the **Crowd Favorite** from the Team Assemblages. Top “chip votes” will determine the winning (Crowd Favorite) piece.

Just after **Googly Time**, when one new component will be given to all teams and must be included in **their assemblage**, the Midway Door Prize will be drawn.

Once time has stopped, and after the ARC prizes and Juried Show prize have been awarded, the Final Door Prize ticket will be drawn. **Ticket holders must be present to win either door prize.** A ticket will be drawn until a winner is found.

The top 3 Team assemblages in both the Best in Show and Crowd Favorite categories will then be sold via Outcry Auction following the announcement of the top winners. The minimum bid for any item in the Outcry Auction is \$25. If any team or team member wishes to keep their creation, they will need to participate in the Outcry Auction and prevail in the bidding process.

The Juneau Radio Center and Angel Montgomery will be live on the radio, and we will have a live feed on our ARC Facebook Page.

All contestants should be prepared to answer questions from the roving moderator. Also, by entering this contest participants agree to the use of your image and/or voice in several ways including, but not limited to local media, photography, radio, video production, newspaper, and social media.

EVENT DETAILS

PLACE: JACC (350 Whittier Street, Juneau, Alaska)

DATE: **Saturday, April 17, 2021**

TIME: Open to public at 12:30 pm

TIME: ARC begins at 1:00 pm

GENERAL AUDIENCE ADMISSION: \$5.00, Children under 10 Free

TEAM REGISTRATION: Register early as space is limited

1. Teams are determined by the first 12 team registrations received. A team is defined as 4 people. One team member must be at least 18 years old. A parental consent form is needed for those under age 18. We recommend one person be assigned as a runner for additional ingredients, tools and adhesives.
2. **Fees per individual:** \$25
 - Teams are made up of 4 people.
 - Registration includes 5 chips per team to use toward the use of a tool, an adhesive or a consultation from an experienced builder.
3. Each team will have an assigned workstation with 2 tables and one electrical drop. Contestants can begin setting up their workstation at 12:00 pm.
4. **Ingredients:**
Juneau-Gastineau Rotary (JGR) will provide all components and accessories for the Assemblages pieces. Contestants may NOT bring Assemblages materials.

Tools and Adhesives:

Each Team may bring their own tools such as: wire cutters/stripper, hack saws, scissors, box knives, hammers, pliers, screw drivers, drills, soldering irons, and glue guns. No welding allowed. Each team may bring their own **adhesives** such as fast drying glue, hot glue, solder, glues or mechanical joinery such as screws and wire.

Adhesives Guide:

When selecting adhesives consider bonding time and if it is safe to used indoors. Below is a link to a "Best Glue for Metals Buyers Guide." It has good information on bonding time and tips for use. Adhesives that state they may be harmful are not allowed such as Beacon Glass, Metal & More Premium Permanent Glue.

- Foodland Hardware store and Joann's both have an extensive adhesive selection.
- JGR will provide a limited but varied selection of **Tools and Adhesives** at a designated tool and adhesive table.

5. JGR will provide a Paint Station, located just outside the facility. All painting must be done in this location. A limited supply of spray paints will be available.
6. **Judging Criteria:**
 - 30% Constructive use of all building materials
 - 30% Execution
 - 30% Recognizable Creation
 - 10% Over the top look and execution
7. Two minutes before the Clock Starts each Team will receive a paper bag with a main component for their build. Since each Team can build as many assemblages as time permits, the component received in the paper bag must be incorporated in one of the pieces built by the Team.

Encouraging your friends, family, co-workers and team sponsors to attend and vote with their Chips and cheer you on is highly recommended. There will be seating for the audience.
8. The “build” portion of the contest will be 150 minutes; Clock starts at 1:00 pm and “hands up completion” is 3:30 pm. As the ARC progresses a “roving reporter” will be checking on your progress and your build. This may take time from your build!

It may be helpful to watch a food contest on Food Network such as Iron Chef, Cake Wars, Chopped or Cutthroat Kitchen to understand the format of this contest.

At some point during the build the clock will be stopped and a Googly (or curveball) will be issued. This surprise component will be given to the team and **must** be included in one of the assemblages at a team's table.
9. **Midway Door Prize:** About halfway through the competition, we will have a Midway Door Prize drawing. You must be present to win, and number will be drawn until a winner is found.
10. After the clock stops at 3:30 pm the final voting count will be completed for the Crowd Favorite.
11. **Final Door Prize:** After the competition prizes and Juried Show prize have been award, the Final Door Prize will be drawn. You must be present to win and number will be drawn until a winner is found.
12. **Recycle the Remaining Assemblages Parts**

All remaining recycle Assemblages parts will be sold at the end of the ARC at a cost of \$5 per bag.

- 3:30** Crowd Favorite Voting Begins
- 3:50** Votes Tallied for Crowd Favorite
- 4:00** Awards Announced
 - ARC:** **Best In Show** -- (Judged) 4 Confirmed tickets on Temsco's Glacier Dog Sled Tour
 - Crowd Favorite** -- Gastineau Guiding Whale Watching Trip for 4!
 - Juried Show:** **Grand Prize** -- 2 Roundtrip Tickets on Alaska Seaplanes, confirmed space-including Whitehorse, Yukon.
- 4:15** Outcry Auction
- 5:00** Final Door Prize Awarded - **Must be present to win!!!**
- 5:00** End of the ARC
