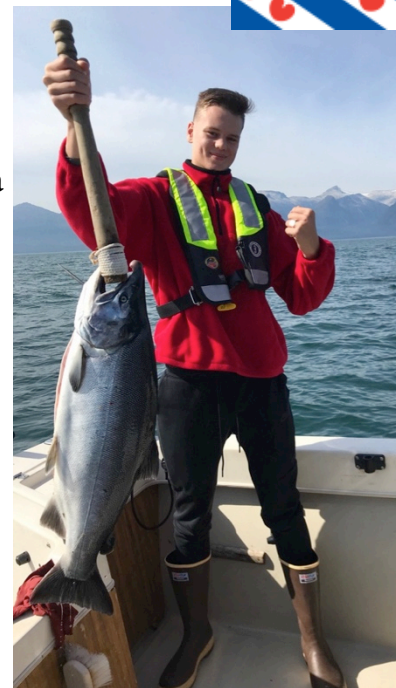

Height, hearts, history: unique Frisia

Inbound Kevin Kooistra hails from a northwest coastal province of the Netherlands, the only among Holland's 12 that has its own language. Kevin lives in Franeker, Friesland. The province has about 20 times the population of Juneau; its 18 municipalities in an area about two-thirds the size of our borough. Its flag reflects the heart-shape of the province. Since the Middle Ages, Friesland has been known for the exceptional height of its inhabitants. In his 1320 epic poem, the "Divine Comedy," Italian poet Dante refers to the "tall Frieslanders."

All 1600+ district Rotarians can download the APP from the Apple iOS store (<https://apps.apple.com/us/app/rotary-district-5010/id1474291618?ls=1>) and/or the Google Play store (<https://play.google.com/store/apps/details?id=org.rotarydistrict5010.app>).
