Networking is necessary tool for successful career adjustment

The pandemic has caused much of the workforce to pivot. While the unemployment rate has recovered by about half – dropping from 14.7 percent in April to 7.9 percent in September – only about half of

the 22 million jobs lost to Covid have returned. Moreover, according to the federal Department of Labor, upwards of 3.8 million jobs have *permanently* disappeared.

So, advice from people like Matt Temple may be in especially high demand. Temple is Senior Director of Alumni Career and Professional Development at the Kellogg School. Kellogg is the well-respected business school of Northwestern University in Evanston, Illinois. Temple earned his own MBA there.

He makes it clear: networking is the most important part of any job search. He notes that 700 million people are part of LinkedIn, an online platform that posts professional employment opportunities and job seekers' resumes'. Today's job hunters should expect interviewing and onboarding to be virtual.

Temple, who is certified in a variety of leadership and training systems, has made hundreds of presentations around the world. He previously worked in private equity with posts in Hong Kong and London. He also served as Director of International Business Development for Ask.com
