

Using art to inform and inspire; new DG has integrated work and passion



Joe Kashi, incoming Governor of Alaska's District 5010, is a bit of a

Renaissance man. He's a trial lawyer by trade; photographer and arts advocate by avocation. Kashi has been a member of the Soldotna Rotary Club for 40 years.

His involvement with photography began in his high school days amongst the Pennsylvania coalfields when he worked at a camera store. While at MIT during his undergrad and graduate years, Kashi was news editor of the campus paper and took photos for the New York Times. While at law school at Georgetown University in Washington, DC, Kashi spent hours in the Library of Congress researching photographic chemistry and processes and began using large format cameras. As technology expanded, Kashi utilized scanning and digitalization to enhance the quality of his photos. His work has been featured in more than 20 solo shows, primarily in campus galleries.

Kashi moved to Alaska in 1977 as one of the first attorneys for the Kenai Borough. In the early 2000s, he integrated his tech and photo skills to strengthen his court cases. He has been active in the American and Alaska Bar Associations, primarily in computer and networking technology. And he remains an active advocate for a regional arts center.
