Anne Zink grew up in Colorado and moved through her training from college in Philadelphia to Medical School at Stanford

and then Residency at University at Utah. As a mountaineering guide she fell in love with Alaska and, after a residency in Emergency Medicine, made Alaska her home. She works out of a yurt behind her house in Palmer.

Zink likes that Alaska is a microcosm of US health care where certain forces like distance, lack of referral centers, and community involvement can help contribute to better systems of care. She quickly became involved in helping improve systems of care as the medical director of her group, then in her hospital. She worked state and federal legislation, including state statutes to improve care coordination, opioid addiction treatment, integration among private systems and the VA, DOD, and IHS facilities.

Zink became Alaska's Chief Medical Officer in July 2019; eight months later, she became the chief advisor on Alaska's strategy to contain the Covid-19 pandemic. Her approach has gained her a Facebook fan club.
