## Jobs grow thanks to external revenue

While Juneau's population has remained flat, the local economy has stabilized despite of six years of reductions in the largest source of jobs: state government. In 2018, employment even expanded 5%, thanks to industries that bring in revenue from outside Juneau: tourism and mining. That's according to the 2019 "Economic Indicators" report from the Juneau Economic Development Council.

JGR member Brian Holst has been executive director of JEDC since 2008. Prior to that, he worked in community and economic development internationally for 20 years. The former Peace Corps member was raised in Juneau and serves on many organizations, including the school board.
