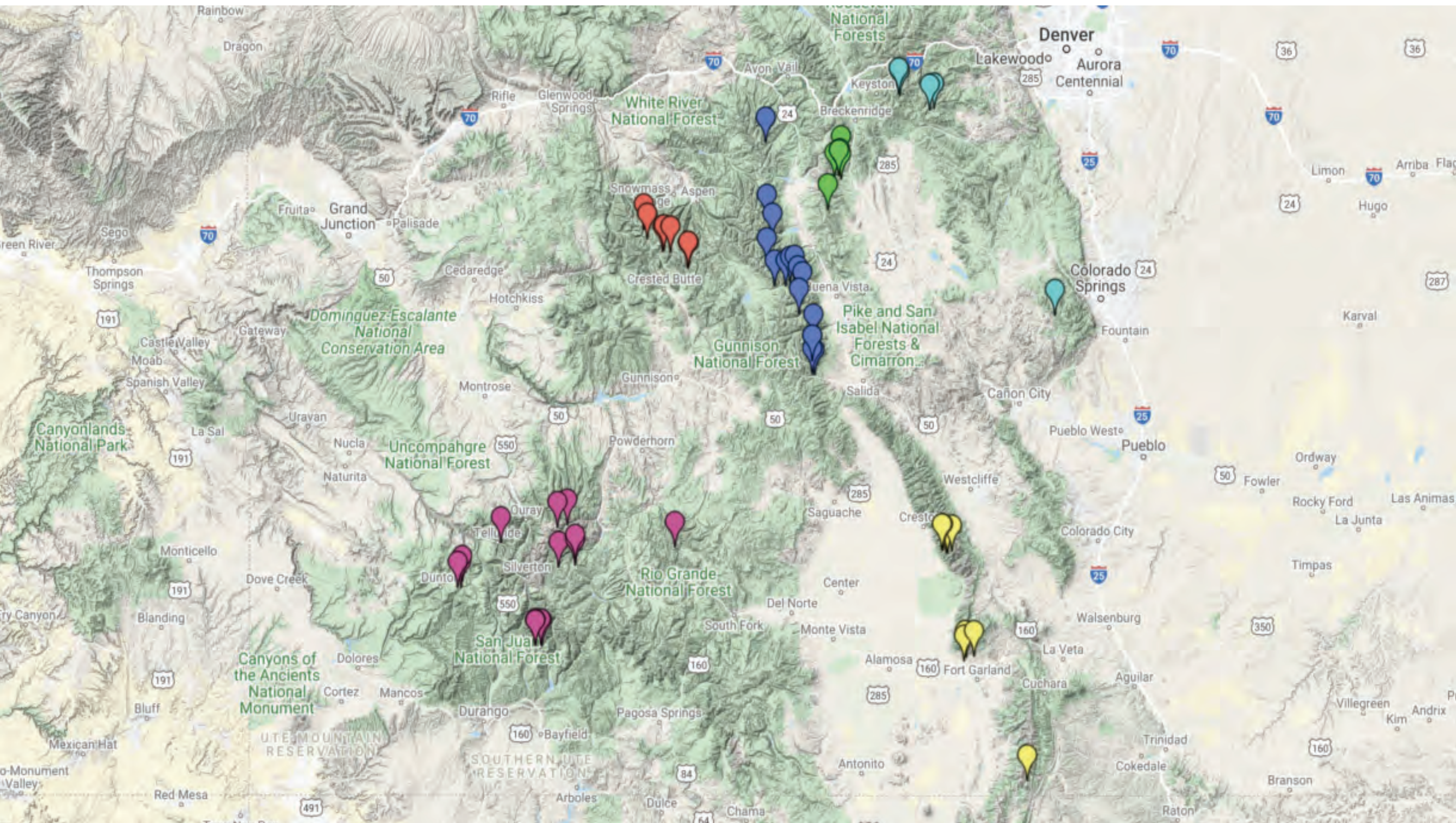

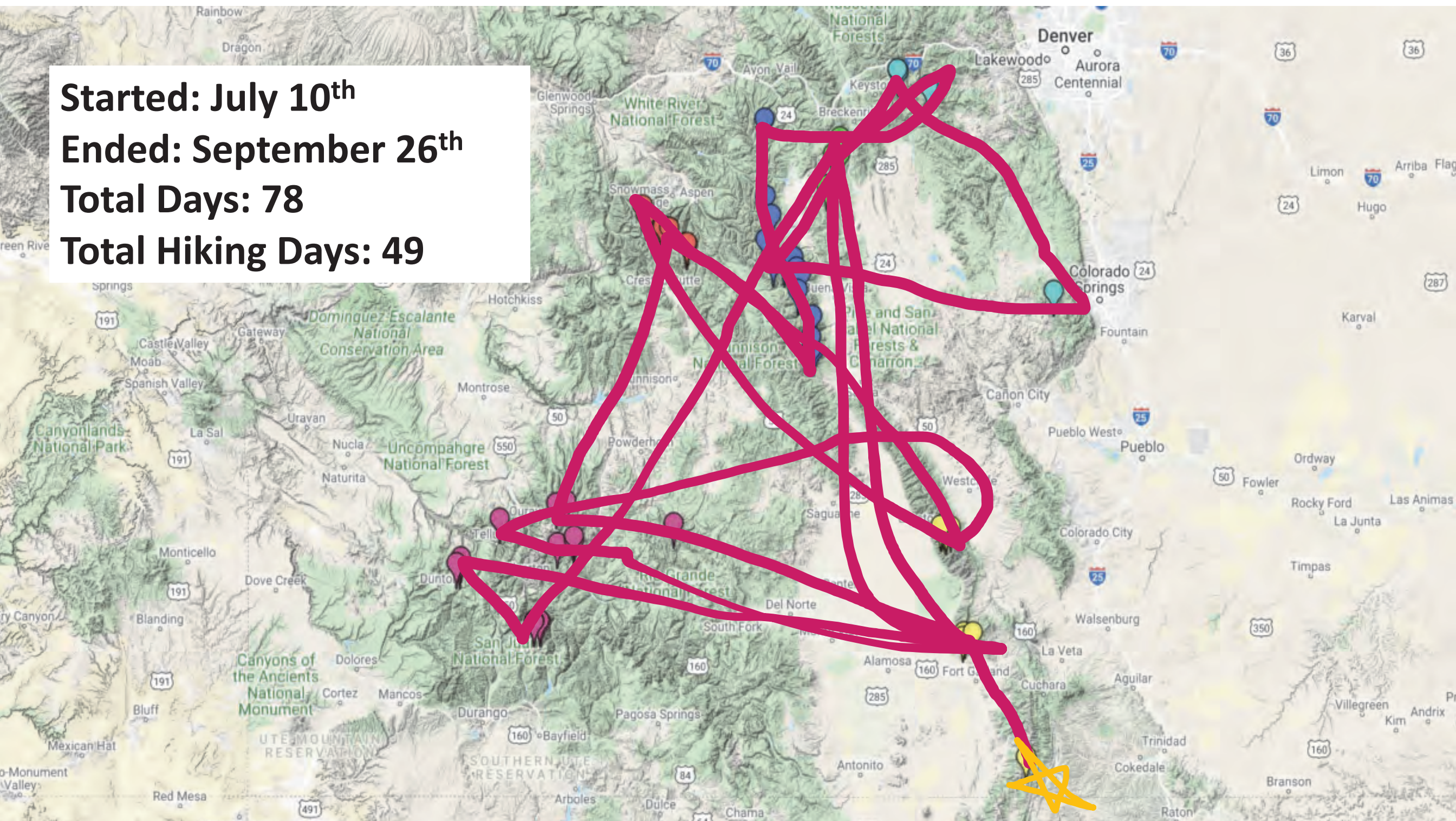


Started: July 10th

your hike?

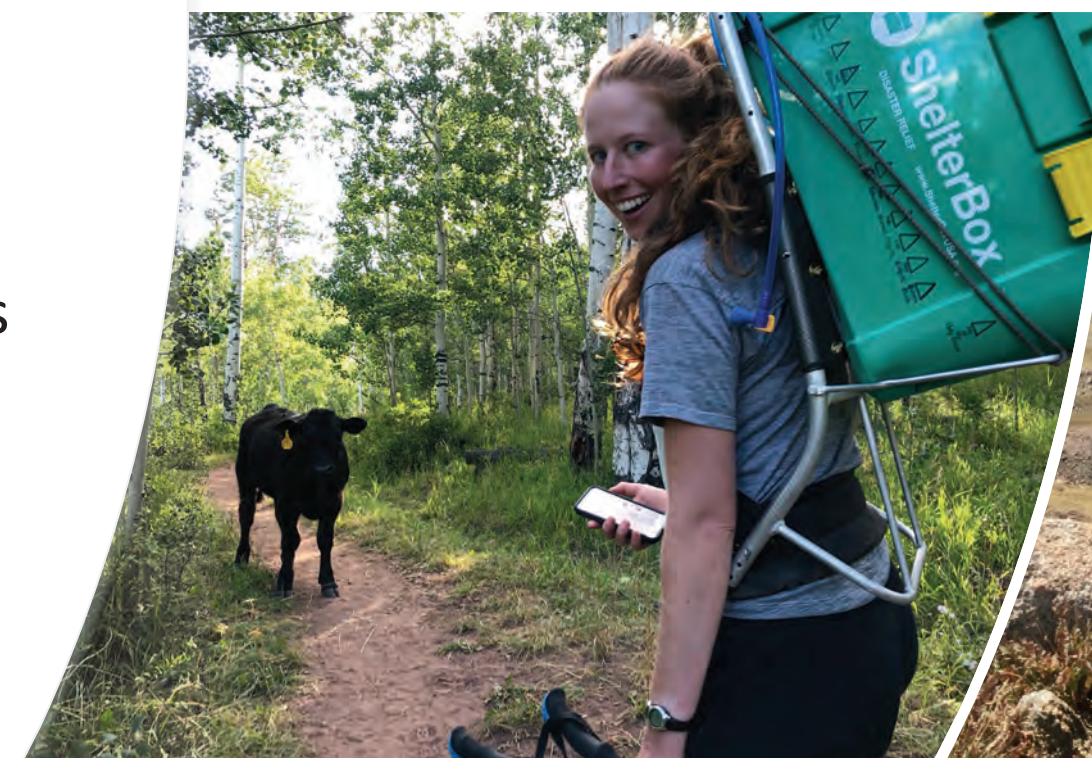
- Fires

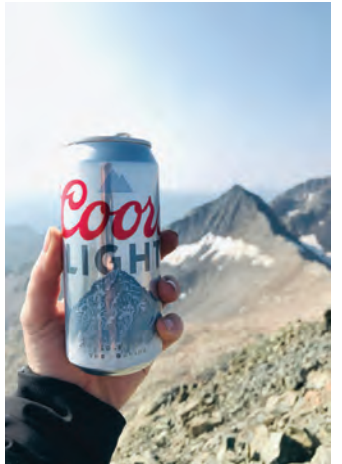
