PASSPORT CLUBS





Passport clubs are Rotary clubs that are using a model that gives members a more flexible club experience, such as frequently visiting other clubs, a relaxed attendance policy, and meetings that don't involve a meal and a speaker.

The term "passport" refers to the ability to move freely from club to club visiting meetings or participating in their activities.

Any Rotarian can visit another club when traveling, but passport clubs encourage their members to do so on a regular basis. This is how passport clubs got their name.
