District 7020 actions DURING a disaster

- Convening disaster specific committee/meetings ASAP
- Establishing & maintaining contact with Clubs on the ground & D7020 island coordinators
- Disseminating disaster info to Rotary & external parties
- Activating Fund Raising promptly
- Record keeping all pledges of assistance & maintaining contact
- Assisting in channeling help for disaster through clubs in need



D7020 Disaster Management Plan

District 7020 actions AFTER a disaster

- Continuing response actions as needed
- Devising effort to help clubs with resources
- Maintaining a helpful, encouraging, responsive & accountable system for clubs to formulate community specific recovery projects
- Moving supplies (pre-positioned or otherwise) to disaster hit areas.
- Channeling financial help to clubs
- Ensuring appropriate project 'stewardship reporting'
- Noting 'learning points' to aid response to future disasters
