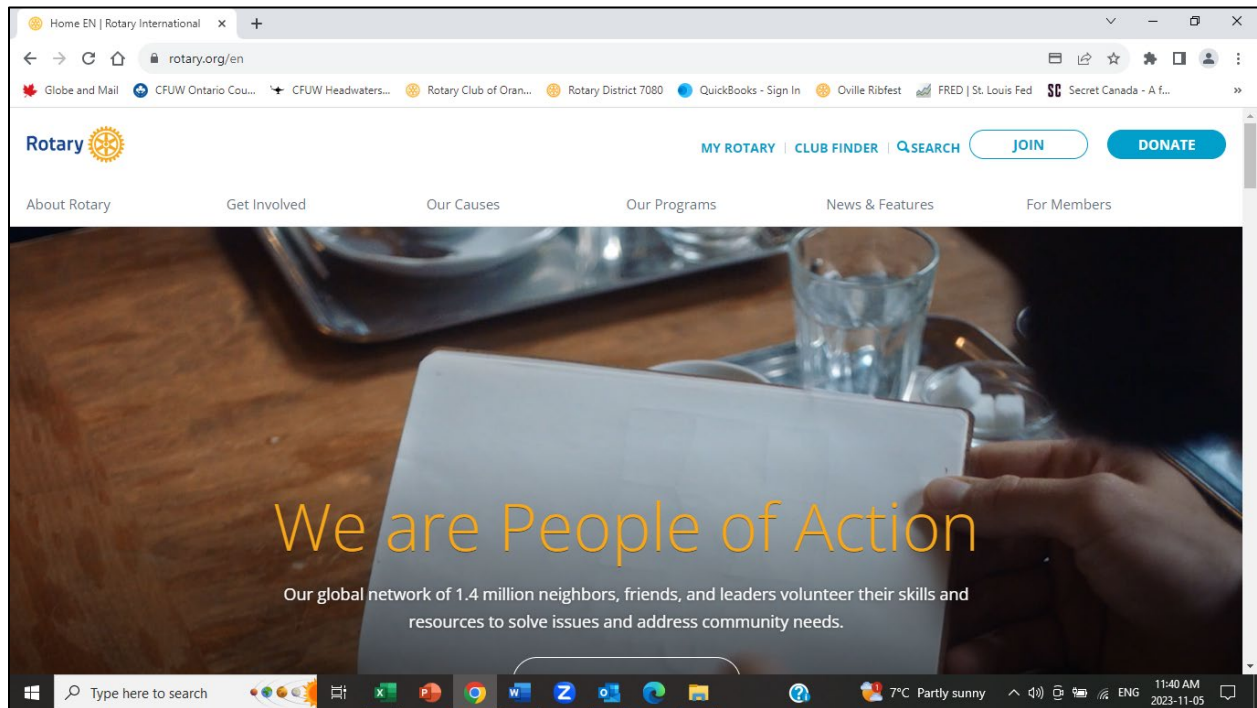
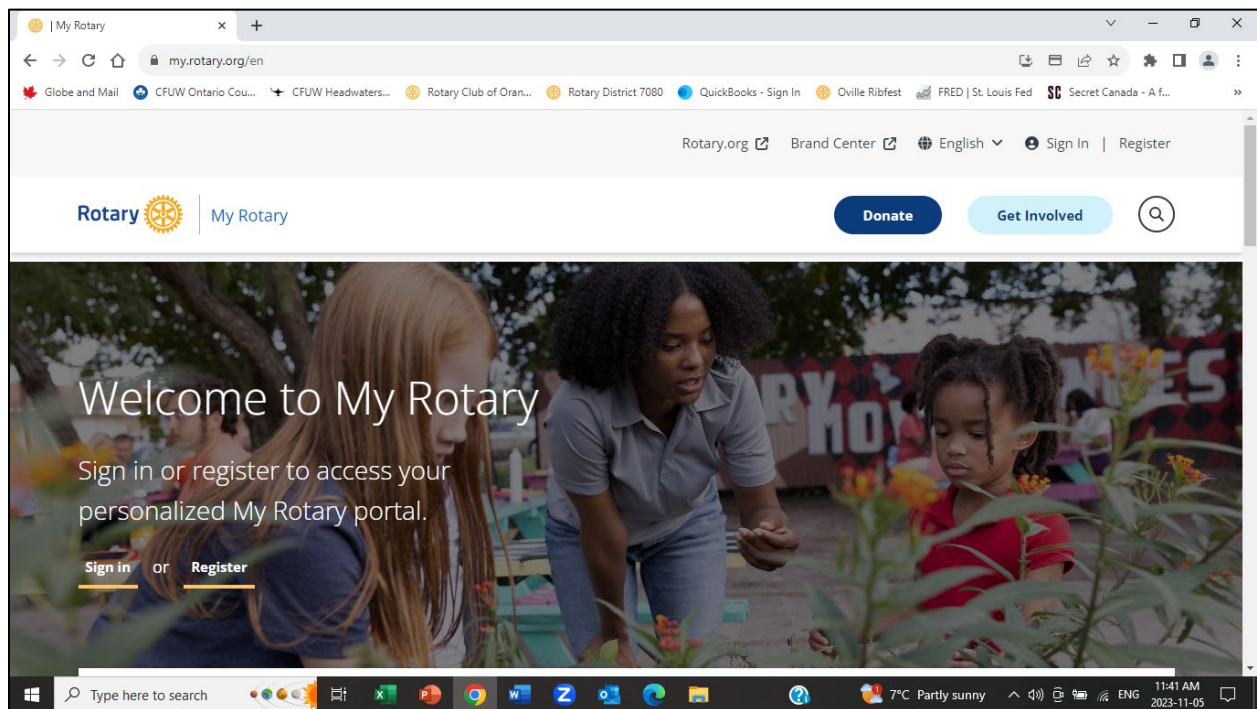


## **HOW TO ACCESS THE ROTARY INTERNATIONAL GRANT CENTER**

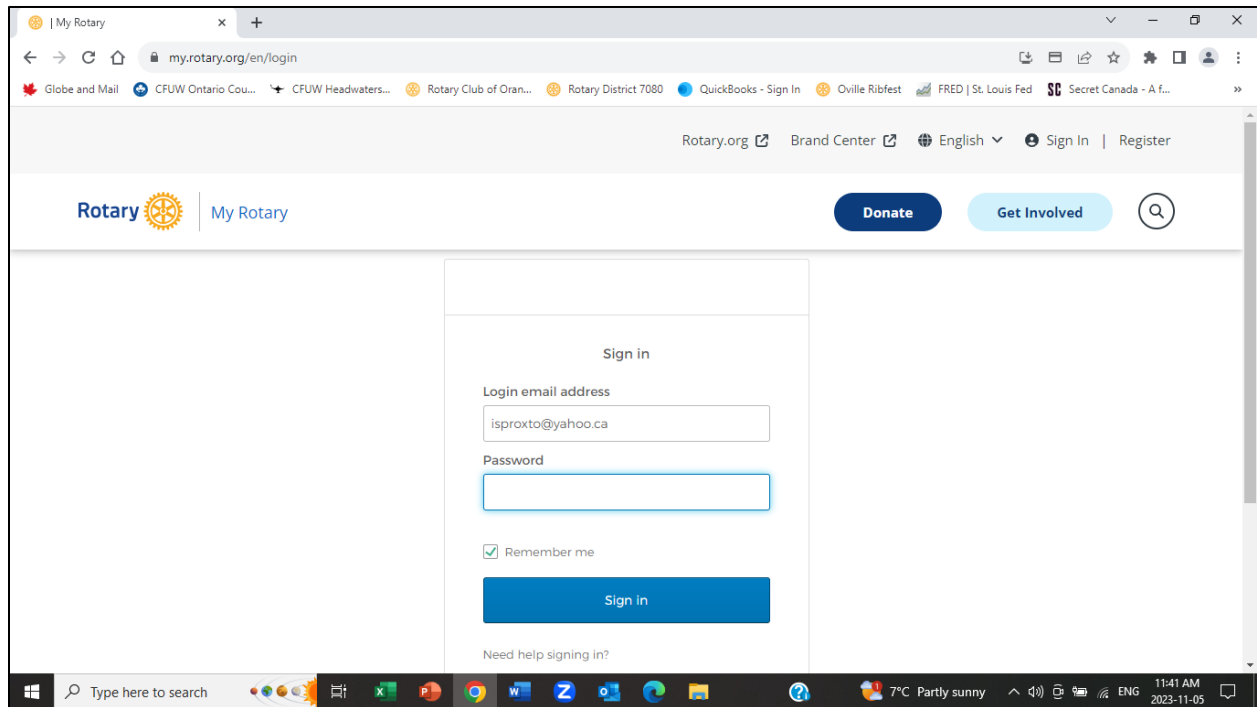
1. Go to the Rotary International website at [Home EN | Rotary International](https://www.rotary.org/en) ([www.rotary.org](https://www.rotary.org/en))



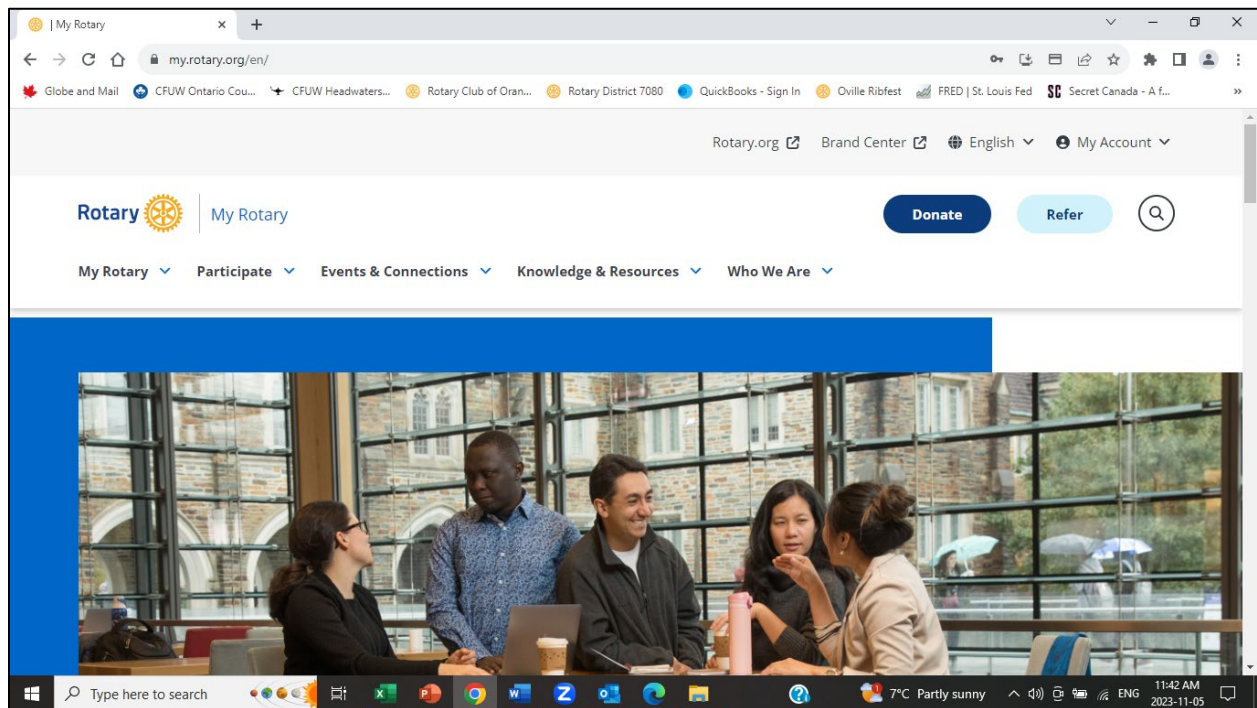
2. Click on MY ROTARY.



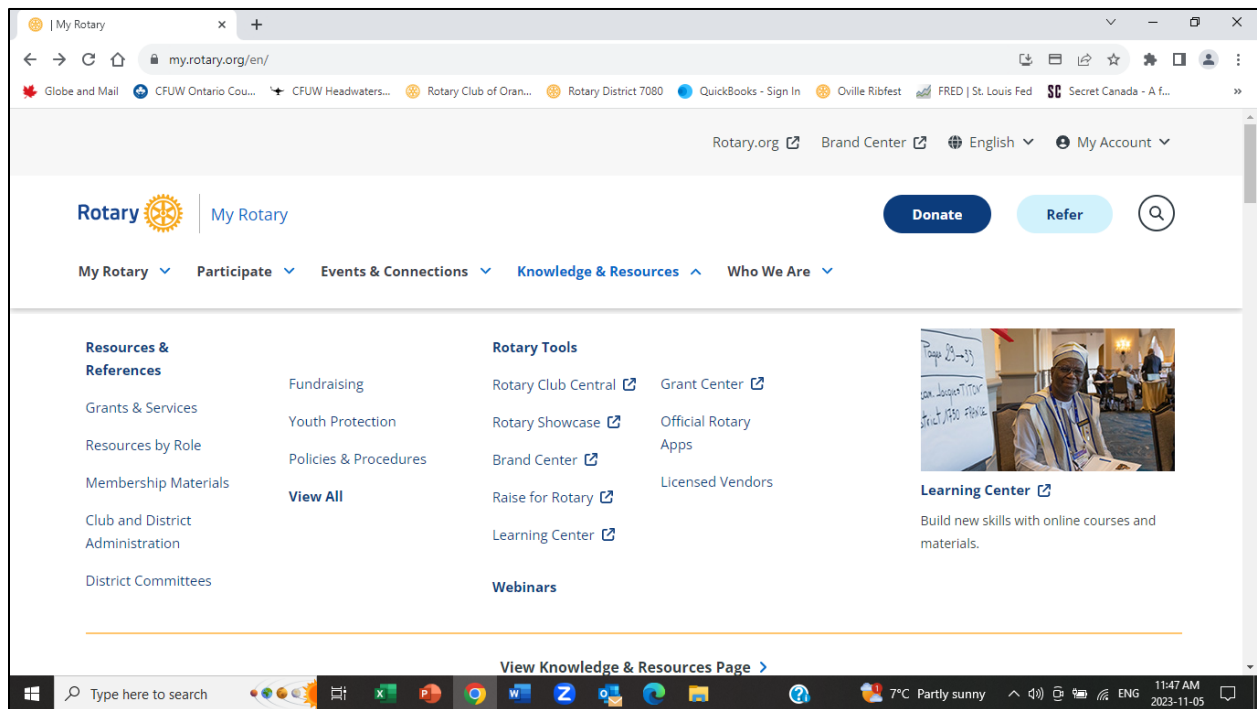
3. Click on SIGN IN.



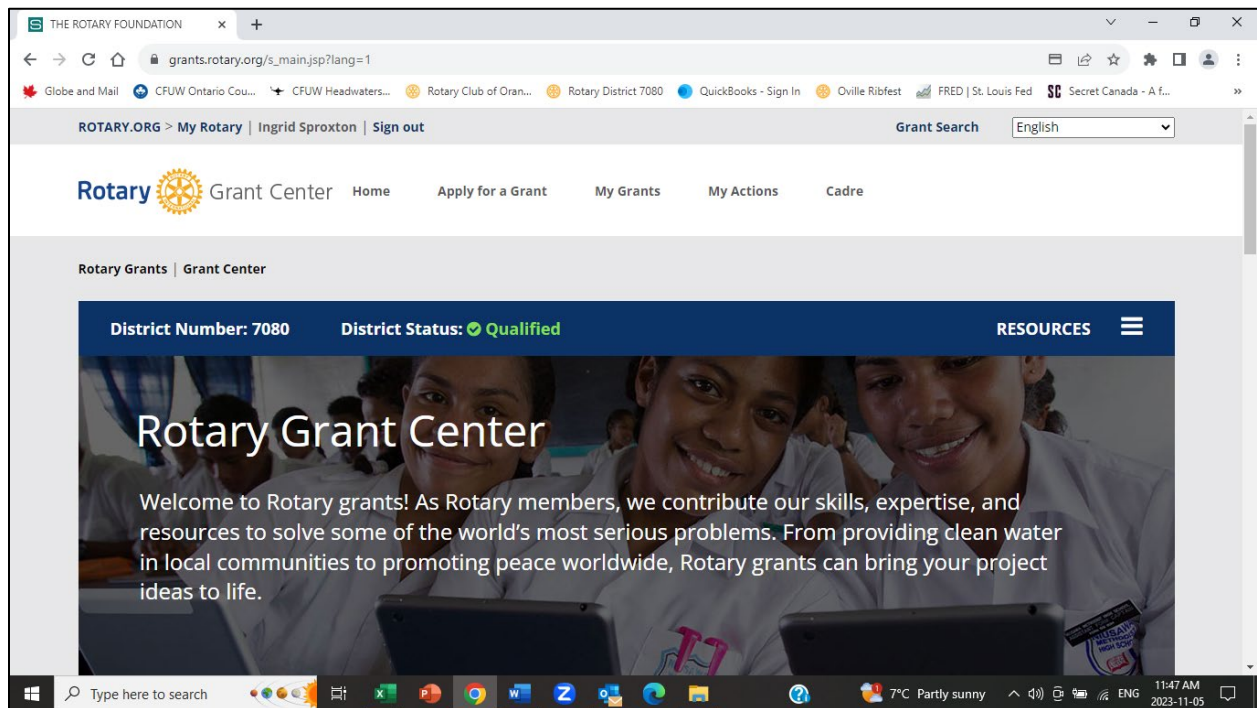
4. Enter your email address and password and click on the Sign in button. The My Rotary screen is displayed.



5. Click on the chevron beside Knowledge & Resources.

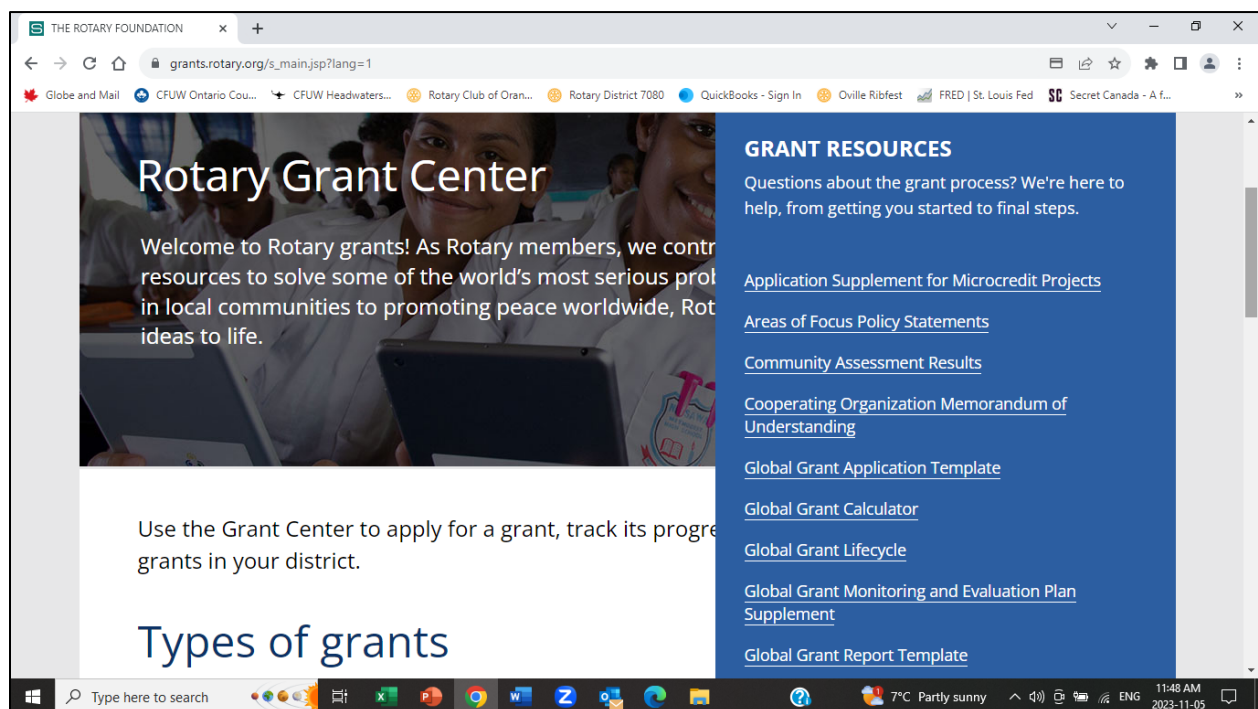
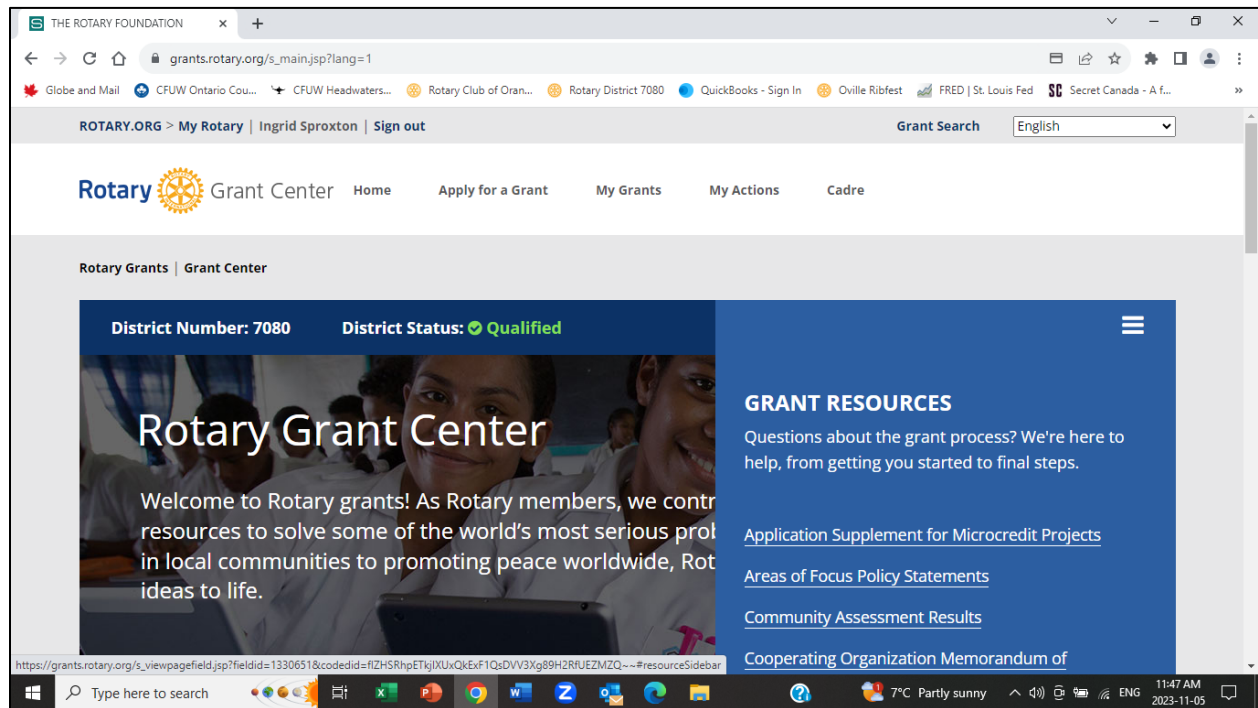


6. Under Rotary Tools, click on Grant Center. Your District number and status are displayed on the Grant Center screen.

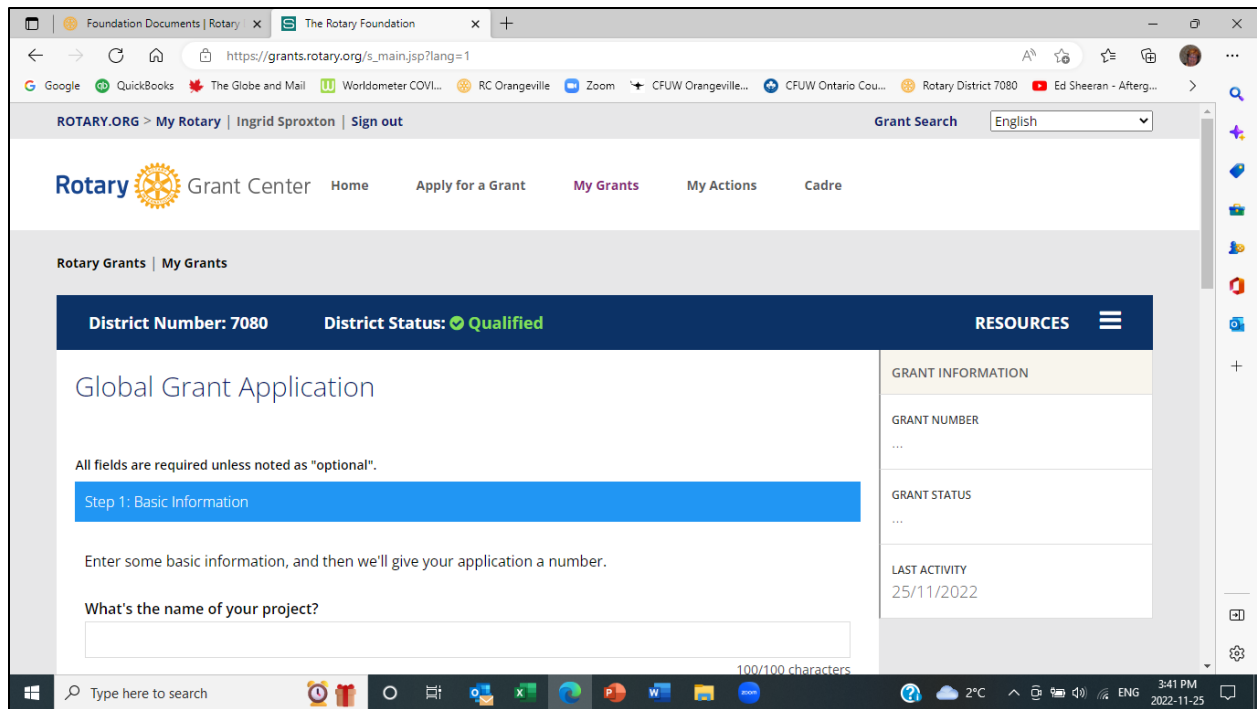
8. To begin a global grant application, click on Apply for a Grant.



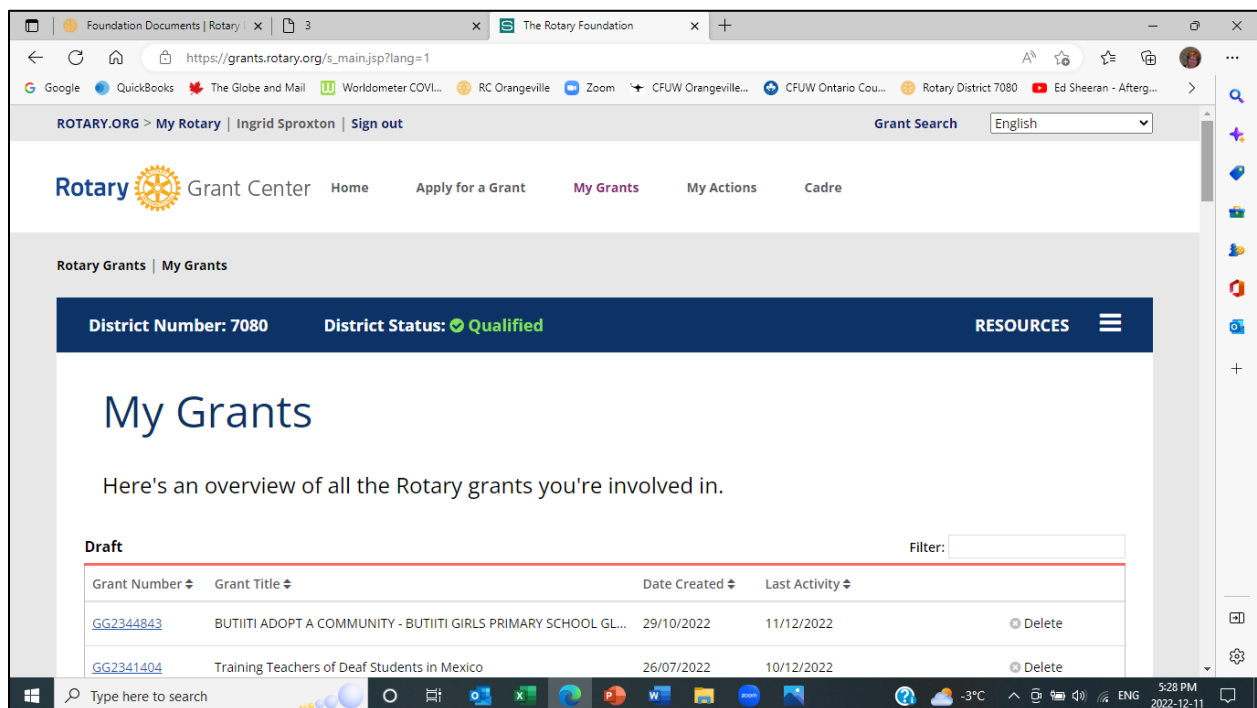
9. Choose Global Grant from the drop-down list for type of grant.
