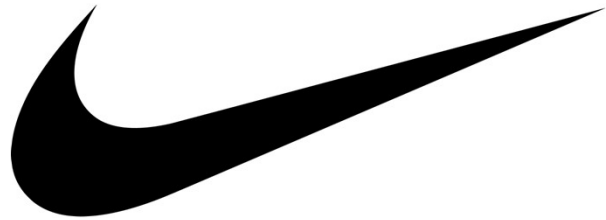

Start by looking at two logos that in my mind automatically associate a message with them.

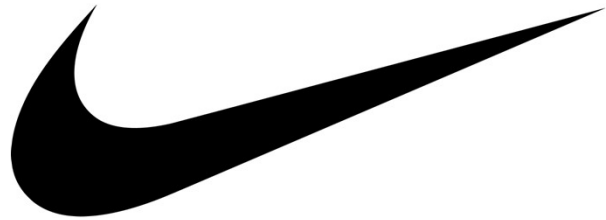

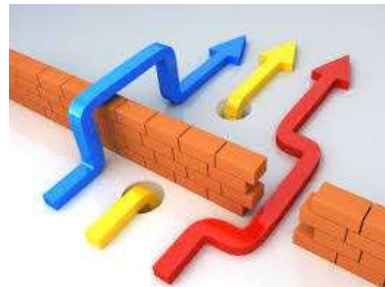

- Personal fear to fail



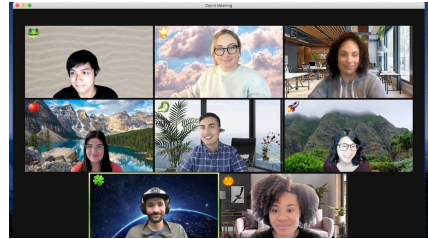

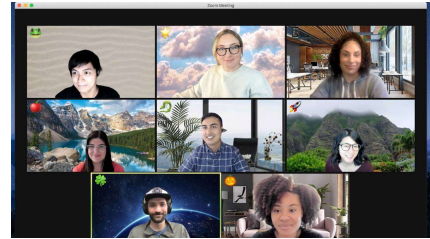

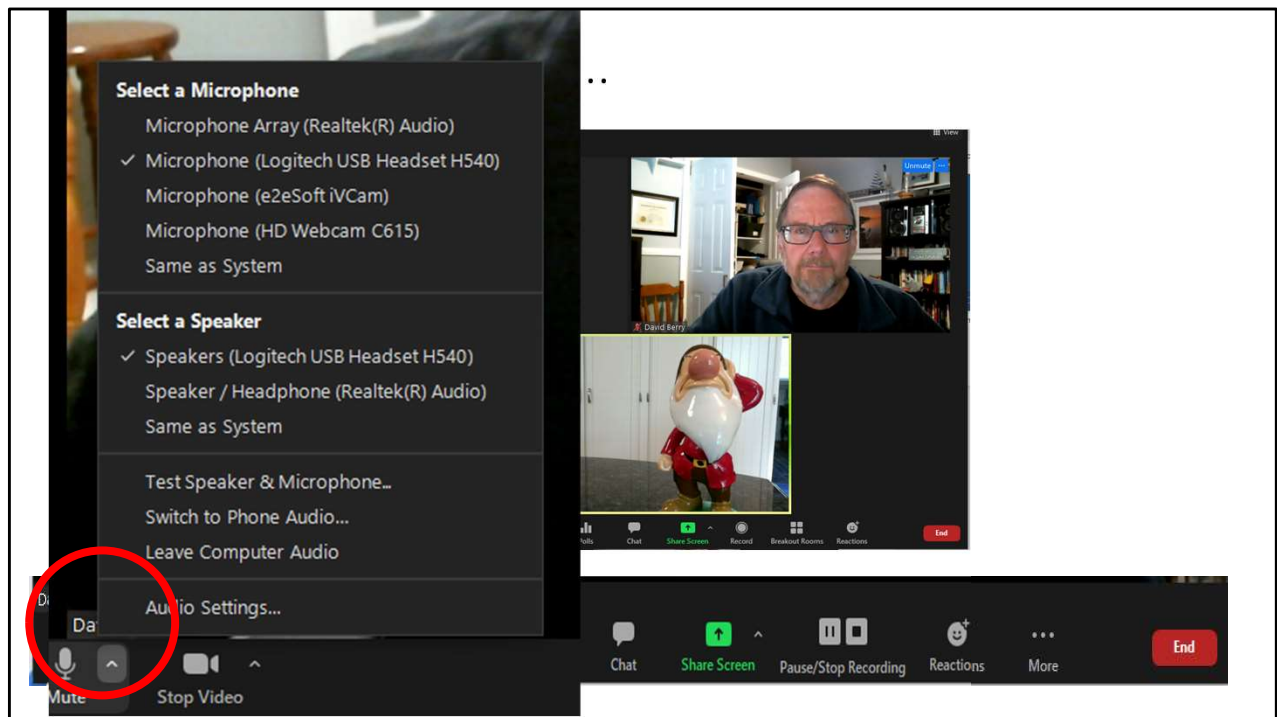
- You have come a long way using Zoom!

Just by attending this zoom meetings you will have noticed that you have gotten better at using the tool.

You have found ... after a couple of times using it ... it got easier to start up and participate Everyone (except me) has with time, remembers to unmute before speaking.



As a host of a VIP meeting the controls are the same.

Just an example of using the tool

If you set up the VIP meeting with two Microphones..... One for the podium and one for the in-room members to use. Simply clicking on the up arrow by the microphone icon open the control panel to change the speaker used.

- **Suggestions**

- Connect directly to the Modem with Cat-5 (ethernet) cable.
- Turnoff the video
- Don't use Virtual Background

Enemy of Good Virtual Meetings

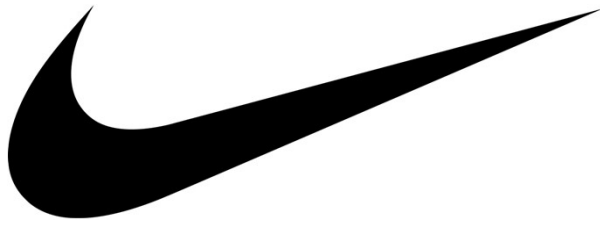
- Poor Internet

- Pull down blinds
- Use Artificial light to control
- Put a light in front of speaker
- Turn off lights behind speaker

Enemy of Good Virtual Meetings

- Poor Internet
- Light
- **Sound**
 - **Everyone speaking in room needs to be at Microphone.**
 - **Microphone to be Omnidirectional**
 - **Small room**
 - You do not need a speaker for room audience to hear those in Cyber land
 - **Large Room**
 - **Must feed room speaker and Virtual sound through a speaker.... (Little more Complex)**
