We noticed the impact that the sudden switch to online learning has had on our local schools due to the Covid-19 lockdowns, and we know that many students are struggling with this new way of learning.

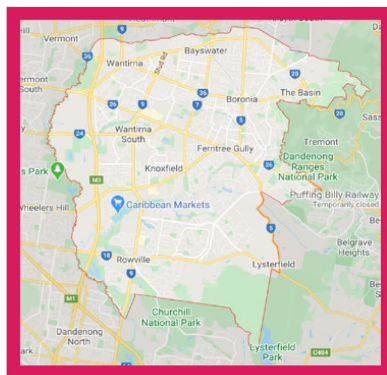
### 2 We can help
