The Rotary Foundation brings us together to unite for good in the world! District 5950 Rotarians contributed more than \$620,000 to the Annual Fund during the 2025-26 Rotary fiscal year. These funds will be used to match Club funds in future projects. In addition, polio contributions exceeded \$278,000, and endowment gifts exceeded \$324,000 resulting in \$1,236,617 in total giving. That is amazing and so generous! Thank you to all Rotarians who participated in the 2025-26 fundraising!

Your donations provided future clean water & sanitation, malaria netting, education opportunities, and economic development in such global locations as Kenya, Nigeria, Uganda, Ghana, Ethiopia, Tanzania, Sierra Leone, South Africa, India, Colombia, Bangladesh, Costa Rica, and many local Minnesota communities. 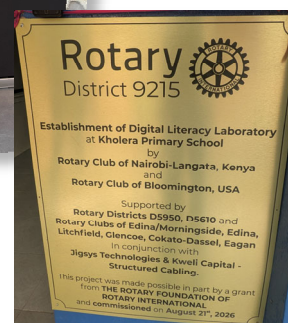


BY THE NUMBERS....

POLIO ERADICATION IS SO CLOSE

2025-26 Polio contributions continue to outpace other Districts with \$278,665 received from Clubs with Brooklyn Park Rotary again leading the way. Gates Foundation matches those contributions resulting in a tripling of dollars that go toward the eradication of Polio. The number of new cases worldwide was 52 through December 2025, and only 18 through July 2026.
