

## Sample Project on Empowering Girls












- In 2020, a community assessment was conducted that determined that the situation in Barabula village in Kwata district was dire. Children were facing various hardships, and it was clear that without intervention things would get worse. After discussion with the village leaders, the Rotary Club of Dar es Salaam Oyster Bay determined that we would raise funds through our flagship event of the Rotary Dar Goat Races, and of the monies raised 50% would go towards supporting children in Barabula village, with a special focus on girls.
- After our intervention, it was noted that 500 girls were now able to study better. We know that the impact of this project will be felt for decades to come as more and more girls (and boys) then teach other students how to also do better. The ripple effects of the intervention will also include the support to communities.
- The intention is to follow up with quarterly visits to ensure that the girls continue to learn, and that boys are no longer harassing them.




