1. DG Nominee Form (RI Form)-signed by applicant and club secretary
2. DG Nominee Applicant Certification-signed by applicant
3. Club Board Resolution-signed by the club president and secretary

An original and two copies of the documents must be received no later than August 7, 2017. Email submissions will not be accepted. Send the documents to:
