

Rotary Road Rally to END POLIO NOW Event Waiver



Road Rally Participants – Agree to the following stipulations:

- 1. Participants agree that they will drive a street legal car, covered by an automobile insurance policy. Your car needs to be road legal and will have to pass a basic safety inspection which includes all working lights, windshield wipers, rear-view mirror, working brakes including a parking brake, seat belts for each occupant, a working horn and tires in road-worthy condition.
- 2. In addition, each entered vehicle must be covered by a valid auto insurance policy as required by the state in which it is registered, and that the policy must be up to date throughout the event. Each car must also be properly licensed and registered with the State. Owner of the vehicle attests to this fact.
- 3. Two people are needed in each vehicle: Each RoadRally team is required to have two people - a driver and a navigator. Anyone on the team planning on driving during the event must also have a valid driver's license. Teammates can be best friends, spouses, and parent and son/daughter, but preferably they would be family members or other people that you regularly see to avoid COVID-19 spread. All participants must wear masks.
 - a. Any team seen where the driver is looking at his/her phone will be disqualified. Hence the need for two people per car.
- 4. Some small stuff: When we say, "Small stuff" we mean something to write with (in order to do some math or make notes on the route instructions) some paper (to do math on) and some type of device which keeps time down to the second usually a watch or smart phone.
- 5. Event participants agree to follow all laws of the road and obey all traffic signs and signals. No speeding is necessary or expected -this is not a timed event.

All participants agree to hold Rotary District 5150, Rotary International, all Rotarians, volunteers, officers, directors, and family members harmless for any accident involving the participants. No automobile insurance is provided by Rotary.
