Information for New Member Applicants

Thank you for considering the Loveland Rotary Club.

Rotary is an international membership organization made up of people who share a passion for and commitment to enhancing communities and improving lives across the world. Our members change lives locally and connect with other clubs to work on international projects that address today's most pressing challenges. Being a member is an opportunity to take action and make a difference, and it brings personal rewards and lifelong friendships in the process.

- As a Member of Rotary, we expect you will exemplify Rotary **Guiding Principles** which encourage and foster the ideal of service:
- Act with integrity and high ethical standards in my personal and professional life.
 - Deal fairly with others and treat them and their occupations with respect.
 - Use professional skills through Rotary to mentor young people, help those with special needs, and improve people's quality of life in my community and in the world.
 - Avoid behavior that reflects adversely on Rotary or other Rotarians.
 - Help advance international understanding, goodwill, and peace via fellowship persons united in the ideal of service.

Celebrating the diversity of the local community and respecting the dignity of all persons, the Rotary Club of Loveland welcomes as candidates for membership adults of good character and good standing in the community.

Subject to the club's constitution, bylaws and status as a private membership organization, adults of every race, religion, creed, national origin, age, gender, marital status, sexual orientation, handicap, disability, economic status or historically underrepresented group, who seek to encourage and foster the ideal of service as a basis of worthy enterprise, are encouraged to become members. To be clear...Rotary has neither a religious nor political affiliation.

The Loveland Rotary Club has membership options to fits your situation. Most members enjoy Tuesday lunch meetings, to hear excellent speaker programs and the camaraderie and networking with others over a great catered meal. If you are connected with a business or organization that would like to encourage more service-oriented participation, we welcome you to review the benefits or the Business/Organization Membership, which entitles multiple individuals from your business/organization to participate in Rotary and partner with Rotary for your service focused projects. Those who find it difficult to join our noon lunch meetings can choose to attend Rotary twice monthly evening meetings which includes a smaller group engagement and focuses on specific projects. Since this meeting does not offer a meal, the membership cost is less per quarter, though meals can be paid for individually if you attend a Tuesday lunch as well. For those who live in the Berthoud area, there is an option to join the Berthoud Satellite Club. (If this is of interest it is best to contact the Berthoud Rotary Club directly at berthoud.satellite@lovelandrotary.org)

Ongoing membership dues are invoiced quarterly and are presently \$250 per quarter for Individual Lunch Members, or \$103 per quarter for Individual Members choosing no lunch or evening meetings. The Business/Organization Membership includes lunch at \$320 per quarter. All dues include support of our local, District, and International Rotary groups. An annual subscription to the International "Rotarian" Magazine is also included. There is a one-time application fee for membership of \$60.00 due when your application is submitted. Individual meals for Guests or non-lunch Members are \$16 (\$18 for special occasions.)

In addition to hands-on service projects, Rotarians donate to two foundations that support our activities and service mission. The *Loveland Rotary Club Foundation* is our club's charitable organization (501c3) and provides funding for our club's service activities as well as grants to other charitable organizations within the area. *The Rotary Foundation* is global and associated with Rotary International, our umbrella organization. Many members opt to donate quarterly, as part of their dues billing. The amount you choose to donate is up to you; many find that \$50 per quarter for each foundation is an attainable goal. Donor recognition is available for each foundation and donations are tax deductible to the extent allowed by law.

Once your application is approved by our Board of Directors, you are an official Rotary member with all rights of membership. Each new member is assigned a current Rotarian "mentor", to assist in quickly getting you acquainted with our members and operations. As a new member, you will wear a Red Badge at our lunch meetings, to help other Rotarians meet and welcome you into the organization.

As part of the "Red Badge" process, you will be asked to participate in at least two different Rotary committees of interests. There are many different committees that support the Loveland Community, and in particular, the Thompson School district, as well as the operation of our own Club. You will have a chance to discuss the alternatives and meet with committee chairs to make your choices. You will find from time to time you will change participation to other committees as you get familiar with our club.

While Rotary does not require attendance at every meeting, you are encouraged to join our meetings to network with other Rotarians, and hear invited guests speak on various subjects of interest. Not only does this encourage your participation in various service activities, but also unites us in a shared sense of purpose to the Rotary philosophy of service and fellowship.

Our international presence also provides a great way to meet Rotarians in almost any city in the world when you travel. All are very welcoming to visitors. Currently the Loveland Rotary Club has approximately 145 members.

We hope this information will help you choose the fellowship and service of the Loveland Rotary Club.
