## Award Categories

There are seven (7) categories in the Club Excellence Awards. You are welcome to apply to all seven, please apply for however many you feel would like – but no less than one (1). Your club and your members deserve the recognition!

- 1. Membership
- 2. Foundation
- 3. Community Service
- 4. Vocational Service
- 5. Youth Service
- 6. International Service
- 7. Public Image

## **Club Size Divisions**

D5000 Rotary Clubs will be divided into three (3) divisions based on club size as determined by the July 1, 2021 Rotary International Club Membership Invoice.

- Small Club Division: 17 & Under members
- Medium Club Division: 18 to 29 members
- Large Club Division: 30 or more members

Awards will be given to the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place finishers within each of the Divisions for selected categories.

## Bonus Points

- Qualifying for the District Governor Citation (2 points)
- Qualifying for the Rotary Citation as of April 10, 2022 (2 points)
- Qualifying for Rotary Days of Service Citation as of April 10, 2022 (2 points)
- Participating in Judging (5 points)
- Percentage Membership Growth of 10% or more (10 points)
- Annual Fund Per Capita Giving Award of \$100 or more (10 points)

• PolioPlus Giving of \$50 per capita or more (5 points)

Instructions for Submitting *Club Excellence Award (CEA)* Applications. This is a simple **2-part process:** 

- 1) **Complete the checklist for each CEA category** and attain at least 250 merit points in each category;
- 2) Attach a narrative to share information highlighting how you successfully accomplished the criteria. Your narrative will help the judges (comprised of Rotary Club Presidents from a club size division other than the one your club is in) rate the submissions. Their task is to select the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place finishers within each of the club size divisions in each award category. You may use one of the following media platforms of your choice:
  - 1-page Written Narrative (8 1/2" x 11" page, preferably in word or pdf, 12-pt font) OR
  - 2-minute Video (maximum 2-minutes)
     If your smart phone can record video with a setting of 4K at 30 fps use this setting, if not. use the next highest 4k setting. If your smart phone's highest setting is 1080p at 30 fps use this setting, if not the next highest 1080p setting. If your smart phone's highest setting is 720p, please borrow a smart phone that can record in 4k or 1080p
  - 2-minute Multi-Media Presentation (maximum 2-minutes). Examples might include a narrated powerpoint, slideshow, photo essay). Be sure to include descriptions so judges know what the visual images represent.

**Submission Deadline**: April 10, 2022: If you have events/activities scheduled to take place after April 10<sup>th</sup>, please indicate in the narrative.
