The Rotary Club of West Springfield considers Community Grant requests of eligible organizations or individuals, subject to funding available in their grant cycle.

Awards are prioritized based on requests which *demonstrate* the maximum benefit to the greatest number of people, with a preference toward benefitting the *local* community.

The Board places a high priority on requests funding capital improvement needs, including specific capital expenses for local 501(c)(3) organizations; have an opportunity to provide *continued benefits* to the community; and which might further an awareness to the goals & ideals of Rotary.

The Committee generally discourages requests to fund entry fees, single events, and applications to assist with annual operating budgets. Additional eligibility guidelines may apply.

Please fill out the grant application completely using additional space on back if necessary.

In order to be considered for this grant cycle, it is important that we have the grant application back to us **on or before the deadline of April 8, 2020.**
