Rotary Global Grant Scholarship Candidate Memo 2023-2024 Academic Year



Global Grants Scholarships for the 2023-2024 academic year are now being offered by District 5970, under the Rotary International Global Grants Program. The scholarships fund graduate level coursework or research, at a minimum of \$30,000 for one to four academic years. Applicants must undertake international graduate study in a field that prepares them for service in one of the seven Rotary Areas of Focus. Applications for scholarship candidates who will begin studies in August, September, or October must be submitted to RI Foundation by May 1. The rest of the year. Global grant scholarship applications are accepted on a rolling basis. Applications must be submitted at least three months before the scholarship candidate's intended departure date to allow adequate time for RI Foundation review and processing.

Below are some key dates for selection of the District 5970 Global Grants Scholar for the 2023-2024 academic year beginning studies in August, September or October of 2023:

Through December, 2022 Clubs & District promote Rotary's Global Scholarship opportunities.

January 1, **2023 -** Preliminary grant applications from the sponsoring Rotary club and candidates are due. The District Scholarship Committee reviews applications and selects qualified applicants.

Feb 1, 2023 - Qualified applicants additional paperwork is due – transcripts, references, etc.

Feb 15, 2023 - Proposed applicants and sponsor clubs are notified of interview decision and schedule.

Mar 15, 2023 – The Grant Committee completes interviews of the qualified applicants.

Apr 1, 2023 – Interviewed applicants and Sponsor Clubs will be notified of decision on or



before this date. District Scholarship Committee will proceed with the two-step grants application process of The Rotary Foundation.

May 1, 2023 – District 5970 submits application to The Rotary Foundation.
