



Now Seeking Applications! YCDT Seeks to Address Opioid Crisis Through Youth Education

Founded in 2004 with help from the Foundation for Enhancing Communities, the United Way of the Capital Region, the Patriot News and many dedicated volunteers, The Youth Community Development Team (YCDT) is a joint project of the Rotary Club of Harrisburg, the Harrisburg School District and Bishop McDevitt High School.

Each year, approximately 40 high school juniors and seniors from Harrisburg schools are selected to participate in the nine month YCDT program. The program encompasses leadership development, community service, involvement and community support. Within this program, each year the students work together to identify an area of community need and raise funds to make an annual grant to a program addressing those needs.

We are pleased to announce that the 2019-2020 YCDT class has selected the Opioid Epidemic as its identified area of need, and is now accepting proposals from nonprofit organizations which seek to address the area of need through education program(s) for youths in 6th-12th grades in the Tri-County area of Cumberland, Dauphin, and/or Perry Counties.

Priority will be given to proposals that include: emotional and mental wellness; prevention; and which take place during school hours. Examples may include, but are not limited to, in-person Ted Talk style presentations; testimonials; first-hand experiences, and experiences that include city and local authorities. Proposed activities may take place within any of the counties eligible for this grant opportunity; proposals are not required to serve all eligible counties. Proposals taking place during school hours must include a letter from the participating school stating agreement to participate.

This grant opportunity is available to 501(c)3 nonprofit organizations, offers a one time-time grant award of \$5,000 and one organization will be selected; applicant organizations must consider how they may provide volunteer opportunities for YCDT students and Rotary Club of Harrisburg members. A full application including all attachments must be received by the Rotary Club of Harrisburg no later than January 22, 2020. YCDT students, their advisors and the YCDT volunteer coordinators will review all applications and attachments and make recommendations for funding. Recommended organizations are required to attend a YCDT meeting to make a brief presentation and answer questions. Please save the date of March 10, 2020 between the hours of 11:00 AM - 1:00 PM to be interviewed. Funds will be issued during a regularly scheduled meeting of the Rotary Club of Harrisburg in May 2020. The grant recipient must attend the specified meeting in order to receive the funds and all grant activities may begin upon receipt of the awarded funds.
