SPEAKERS REVIEW by Danielle Mortimer

Thursday we welcomed Dr. David Ehrenkrantz and Bob Lankin from the Rotary Club of Northeast Sunrisers in Philadelphia. They presented to us the Heal Pignon Haiti Project. In 2010, Haiti endured the worst national disaster ever; a 7.0 magnitude earthquake that killed 160,000 people, while leaving nearly 1 million people homeless. This earthquake devastated Haiti, but the resilience of residents and support of the international community is helping Haiti overcome the disaster.

Haiti is striving to achieve Sustainable Development Goals including sustaining good health and well-being by increasing health financing and the recruitment, development, training and retention of the health workforce in developing countries. The Heal Pignon Haiti project is aiming to improve knowledge and competencies of experienced nurses and new nursing graduates. It is a non-profit organization dedicated to training and mobilizing young leaders to improve health care and save lives.

Heal Haiti uses a two-week clinical trial to train the nursing professionals. The training is led by 5 Americans and 1 Haitian coordinator along with 5 Haitian Teaching Assistants with Heal Haiti experience. This initiative represents a start-up effort to partner with the Rotary Club of Pignon, the Rotary Club of Northeast Sunrisers Philadelphia, The Hospital at Pignon (Hopital de Pignon) and Heal Haiti to provide graduate nurses with a "home base" to obtain much needed training. The project will use results from a pre-service training workshop conducted in 2018 for nursing students to enhance their knowledge and skills regarding service delivery to 6,500 underserved Haitian patients. Ariel Edmonson and Gretha Fievre are two Heal Haiti members who joined our meeting. We appreciate our guest speakers' time and efforts!
