Deb Sparre introduced **Jolene Wilson-Glah**, who has been living as an expat overseas. (An expat is somebody who leaves their country of origin and settles abroad for an extended period of time, often permanently).



Raised in West Chester and a Henderson graduate, Jolene was a speaker at

our club last in 1969. She was an exchange student heading to Sweden and her sister was also an exchange student en route to Bolivia - both courtesy of our club!

Jolene's parents worked for TWA. Her dad lived in 35 countries and her parents urged them to explore the world. She stated that "traveling is the biggest defense against bigotry and ignorance" you'll find in life.

In 1992, she had a busy career, got back in touch with a Norwegian boy who'd been an exchange student to West Chester – and they got married. They traveled the world for 20 years but when her marriage ended, got back to working full time and moved back to WC to care for mother (she passed in 2013). Then she got a notification about going to Ecuador to learn about being an Expat in the Andes Mountains. She went, but came back home and was working as a trial lawyer. In 2014, she was diagnosed for third time. She closed her practice and moved to Ecuador and has been there for the last 10 years. "Smartest thing I ever did" Jolene says. She's been to over 40 countries in her life.

Ecuador living: You can live on \$1,000 monthly income. Life is very inexpensive and they use the US dollar. She pays \$500 monthly rent for a 2,400 sq ft apartment. There have been zero mass shootings because guns are illegal there.

There are two very active Rotary clubs in her city in Ecuador which shehappily frequents.
