SPEAKERS REVIEW by Kyle Rheiner

Last week, we welcomed Steve Trubey, Community Relations Manager for Surrey Services for Seniors to our luncheon.

Surrey Services is a 38-year-old Chester County non-profit with a mission to help older adults live with independence and dignity and to continue as engaged members of the community. Now, they're not only providing transportation to/from appointments - they're also providing in-home care, live-in care, house cleaning, personal care services, RN Care Management and even more services.

Beginning in 1981 in an attic, they've grown to five Senior Centers and also have a nice consignment shop in Berwyn! They now have 4,500 members across those locations with a \$50/annual fee. The minimum age is 60 with a mean age of 78.

Last year, Surrey Services provided:

48,000 meals delivered via meals on wheels 70,000 hours of home care services 29,000 meals at their locations 16,000 rides - volunteer, shared, personal driver - dr, Grocery, errands,

They also provide FREE dental care for their members.

Surrey Services has 2 large annual fundraisers: A gala in May, and a golf outing in the September. You can subscribe (and advertise) to their monthly newsletter that has a circulation of 7,000 subscribers.
