SPEAKER'S REVIEW BY Kyle Rheiner

On a day where we had two different speakers, we had two similar paths. Both included hard work, determination, sports and family.

Donning a fedora and a Steelers lanyard and tattoo at our podium, **Tara Webber**, tells us how she arrived in Chester County by way of Pittsburgh, PA. She is now the CEO of the Chester County Family Academy on Union Street in West Chester. But the journey has had numerous detours.

She recalls her father coming home from work at the steel mill daily, covered in black dirt, sweat and made time to teach the family about the importance of teamwork.

Growing up, Tara loved sports. She played softball with the girls, football with the boys and then one day discovered her love for basketball. Eventually, that landed her a basketball scholarship at Seton Hill

University in PA. She was the first of 5 to attend kids and graduate college. She studied to become an English teacher and it's paid off. She got into coaching basketball while she earned her master's degree and Principal's Certification in NYC.

Tara spent time in Japan, teaching the English language to students in Japan. She moved to Nicaragua to teach and during that time, was bit by a scorpion and her roommate assured her "that's not the poisonous kind." Poison-free, she brought women's basketball to Nicaragua in 2005 and was the first woman to ever play basketball in their Parque Central (central park). The students idolized her.

Moving back to the US, she helped coach and teach troubled kids in New Hampshire, got a Master's Degree in Special Education and then took an Assistant Principal job in Chicago. Soon after, Tara moved back to Pittsburgh to take care of her mother and become a principal. The pandemic struck and Tara was laid off from her job as principal. Now, she's the CEO of Chester County Family Academy. She's loving it. The students take Karate, learn Yoga and the importance of discipline and breathing techniques. They take cooking classes, violin, drumming, and swimming courses.

Tara has been a club member since September 2020.

Next, we have **Jim Nelson**, the last person inducted into our group before COVID19 shut down our meetings.

He's a Wealth Advisor with Merrill Lynch in Wilmington DE and also has lived in many places.

Jim has Air Force parents and therefore, he's lived in 9 states and 2 countries.

From 1993-1997, Jim played college football at Penn State under the tutelage of Joe Paterno and then spent 8 seasons playing professional football in the NFL. Jim has played Linebacker for the Packers, Vikings, Colts and Ravens. Fast forward, he's the Founder of *Big League Haircuts* and has led that charge for 17 years now.

As mentioned, he's a Wealth Advisor, his wife is a 4th grade teacher and together they have 3 children. He loves to coach, golf, play guitar and stress the importance of teamwork and being open-minded.

We're very happy to welcome in our new Rotarians, Tara and Jim.
