From the club's history files ... 70 years ago!

The Rotary Votary of July 7, 1953 reported that the club's official attendance for the 1952-53 Rotary year was 87.4%. Sixty-four members had above average attendance including 31 with 100% perfect attendance. *The Votary* also published the names of 22 members who MISSED the last meeting. Shame, shame!

The Thursday, July 9, 1953 club meeting was held at the Mansion House Hotel at 12:10 pm. The speaker was Harry Buckley, Supervising Agent of the Pennsylvania Railroad at the 30th Street Station.

Ed. Note: the Mansion House Hotel (originally the Chester County Hotel) stood on the SE corner of Market and Church Streets from 1832 to 1972.
