Sheriff Bunny Welsh that the 6th annual "Shop with the Sheriff" will be held on Saturday December 14th at the Kennett Square Walmart. Walmart matches each \$50 donation with another \$50 and the children are given a \$100 gift card for shopping. Children from the Family Academy are busy making their lists. They shop with a law enforcement officer in uniform. This helps encourage a bond and positive attitude toward law enforcement. The children may not buy for themselves. SPEAKERS REVIEW by Charles Streitwieser

Classification Talk by **Jeff Spencer**: Jeff became the CEO and Scout Executive of the Chester County Council of Boy Scouts of America in January of this year. His Boy Scout career began in high school: he attained the rank of Eagle Scout at 16 and worked each Summer for a Boy Scout camp. After college, he went to work full time for Boy Scouts. Last weekend, the Chester County Council of Boy Scouts celebrated their 100th anniversary, recognizing 5,700 youth in the program supported by 2,500 parents. Jeff pointed out that the Scout Reach program serves 522 underprivileged kids to afford scouting each year. The next era of the Chester County Council will begin in 1 ½ years when their new headquarters will be completed in Exton.

Currently working as an Independent Curator for The Cocoa Exchange, Arlene helps others how to do great food, gifts, and fundraising with cocoa.
