Amelia Rayburn-Pizzica, granddaughter of former Rotary Club member, **Dave Rayburn**, spoke on behalf of the Domestic Violence Center of Chester County which focuses on outreach and education as a means of prevention.

Founded in 1976, its mission is to prevent, reduce, and remedy domestic violence and its service is free and confidential.

As a lifelong Chester County local and West Chester University graduate, Amelia Rayburn-Pizzica works as the Director of Education Programs for the Domestic Violence Center of Chester County (DVCCC). With the organization since 2012, she began as a volunteer, joined the staff as their Children's Service Coordinator, and assisted in growing the DVCCC Education Department that she now oversees. Amelia has a passion for and commitment to increasing awareness of the issue of family and intimate partner violence in her community and, specifically, supporting children and teens who experience this issue as both victims/survivors and within their families.
