Miss Melrath spoke on behalf of Chester County ACEs Coalition (Adverse Childhood Experiences).

ACEs are traumatic events that a child experiences before the age of 18. A survey conducted in 1997 shed light on the impact that trauma has on our lives. Stress, specifically in childhood, impacts our life long health.

## **GEUST SPEAKER (continued)**

This survey consists of a series of questions. These questions determine the extent of stress a child endures and determines the basis and severity of the trauma.

The trauma that results is due to:

Neglect Abuse

Household dysfunction

# **IMAGINE ROTARY – Rotary International Theme 2022-2023**


