Over the years, this project has help provide 15,000 homes that are warmer, safer, and drier.

Adults can participate all year round and Youths 14 years and older throughout the summer.

The cost is \$350 per volunteer for lodging and food. Transportation would be an additional cost.

Only one in five homeowners' applications are usually accepted.
