SPEAKERS REVIEW by Derek Chandler

Due to a last-minute cancelation, **Past President Bill Ronayne** stepped in without missing a beat. A volunteer firefighter since 1974, Bill was first

persuaded to the honorable work with a parade and a \$2 beer social event. Thankfully his love for humanitarian work and automobile repair, Bill has continued serving to this day. Over the years, he has held the department position of Engineer, Lieutenant, Captain, and Assistant Chief. Currently his crew, three fire stations and one ambulance, serves five different townships which accumulates to about a population of 45,000 in a radius of over twenty-seven square miles.

Serving as a volunteer firefighter is truly a labor of love and is a brotherhood among its members. Most of the community is unaware that local departments are ran by volunteers, in fact 97% of Pennsylvanian fire departments are volunteer, considerably higher than the national average. Thankfully most calls are not serious in the area but, the 2019 fire at Barclay Friends Nursing Home reminds Bill, and other local volunteers alike, how dangerous and deadly fire can become. Last week's Hurricane Ida even resulted in over thirty calls for water rescues. Statistically speaking, unattended cooking is the number on reason for residential house fires.... but in actuality its common irresponsibility and stupidity.

Even though **Bill Ronayne's** love for intoxicated sick college students is insurmountable, the local community of West Chester is exponentially better with Bill and the Ronayne family as residents. Unfortunately, his hockey skills are not as admired.
