Katie was very excited to tell us about the 94th Old Fiddler's Picnic that's to be held this Saturday August 12th at Hibernia Park in Coatesville.

Known originally as the "Chester and Delaware Counties' Old Fiddlers'," the event was conceived and organized



by S. L. Anderson, a teacher and historian whose many talents included playing the fiddle.

This was a Chester County gem of an event that began in the early 1900s. After years of success, it began to fizzle out a little in the 1980s. After doing some research into the

history of the Old Fiddler's Picnic, Katie fell in love with the idea and then helped to resurrect the event. For the first 54 years, this was held in Lenape Park, but then moved to Hibernia Park, where you'll find it today.

Fiddlers from numerous states flock at the opportunity to play this event and they get quite sad when it's all over.

Come enjoy the stage show with over 7,000 attendees or stroll through Fiddler's Cove to listen as musicians play tunes using a variety of instruments such as guitars, banjos and mandolins, performing styles such as bluegrass, old-time, and gospel.



Children and those new to string instruments are encouraged to learn by observing and talking to the musicians in this relaxed atmosphere and you can even participate in the fiddling competition to win awards and prizes.
