She's helped bridge the gap and keep an 80-year relationship alive with the Marshallton United Methodist Church and launched GLDN - the Growth and Leadership Development Network to mentor the youth and create lifelong relationsships.

In a Post-Covid world where many were lonely and sad, she founded a program called SERV to help harness the enthusiasm of students to better the lives of our friends living in the impoverished bateys of the Dominican Republic.

She's raised tens of thousands of dollars and her team has provided over 7,000 hours of community service with her programs for others.

She and 18 fellow students from St. Mark's High School (Wilmington) will be heading to the Dominican Republic for service work this summer. It'll be her 4th visit!
