TC Slush - Christine Wildauer

(I always double this recipe)

- 1 6 oz. can frozen orange juice
- 1 6 oz. can frozen lemonade
- 4 tea bags
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1 cups Vodka
- 1 cups boiling water
- 7 cups cold water

Steep tea bags in 1 cup boiling water for 15 minutes.

Meanwhile in a large pot mix all other ingredients together, stir well so the sugar dissolves.

Add tea and pour into a plastic container, preferably not more than 4 inches deep for faster freezing time (usually 1 day).

Prior to events I take a sharp knife and chop it up for easier serving.
