Matt Kane, a former member of our club spoke to us about his family's effors to sponsor a Ukranian family's move to West Chester.

Matt's Wife Shayna is Ukrainian and they were married 40+ years ago at St. Peter and Paul Church in Phoenixville which has a great number of Ukrainian families.




They were working on ideas to

support Ukraine, such as packing

boxes of supplies for refugee camp families in Ukraine here at the St. Peter and Paul Church in West Chester, and the community donated \$1,500 cash – the same day they discussed the topic!

In the following weeks, families began bringing car loads of supplies to the church. They totaled 130 moving boxes filled with supplies and \$30,000 in cash!

They've utilized the website Welcome.connect to find families to sponsor. Within days, 30 families asked to be sponsored. The Kane's identified and worked through many important factors that were important to them regarding the family they would sponsor and they finally found one. It's a family consisting of a husband, wife, two teens and a grandmother. The husband will have to remain in Ukraine as males age 18-60 are not allowed to leave. So, the Grandmother, Wife and two kids are coming to West Chester with the Kane's.
