Once joining America Online, Darren saw the beginning of Ecommerce. With the tragic sudden death of his three-month-old, a non-profit was started "Simons Heart". Simons Heart works with many large companies including Scrub Daddy, Speedo, and the Philadelphia Flyers.

The main goal of the Unless Agency is to find was to align companies to great causes which increase profits while simultaneously improving society. Some stats provided from Darren regarding the current workforce:

71% of employees feel disconnected.40% of employees consider leaving their job.89% believes a strong sense of purpose drives companies,
